Rehabilitation Services

The rehabilitation program is founded on the philosophy that excellent quality rehabilitation can and should be delivered in a sub-acute setting. We deliver a comprehensive, interdisciplinary program with a focus on timely response and early initiation of the rehabilitation program to optimize residents' recovery. Physical, occupational and speech therapy are available seven days a week. Two therapy gyms are available with state of the art equipment including: Electrical Stimulation, Short Wave Diathermy, Ultrasound and an Omnicycle. We also offer extensive occupational training in our newly remodeled kitchen that reflects what most patients may have in their own homes.

The therapy staff works closely with both the medical and nursing teams to ensure the patient reaches their optimal level of functioning. Our long-term residents also receive an evaluation of their needs annually, and as needed. Our goal is to assist the residents to reach the highest practical level of functioning, and maintain this level long-term.



Long Term Care

While choosing a long-term care facility for a loved one is never easy, you have the assurance of knowing that they will have access to comprehensive services, an extremely caring and experienced staff; and to a varied choice of recreational programs that will help them to create new friends and experiences.



CARE AND SERVICES

Short Term Care

Patients who receive hospital care for an illness, surgery or trauma may be referred to our facility by the hospital, a physician or a family member. In addition to our physical, occupational and speech therapy, we provide rehabilitative and nursing services for orthopedic, cardio-respiratory, and post-stroke patients. Our skilled nursing team also provides wound care and intravenous therapy. In conjunction with area hospitals, we provide a continuum of care for our patients. Our Admissions Director will work in tandem with all parties, including insurance companies, to evaluate the patient's needs, determine discharge dates (from both the hospital and our facility), and ensure a smooth transfer to and from our facility. We're happy to serve all of our patients. We are happy to serve all of our patients; and even happier when we can help them return to independent living...and of course, so are they!



DESIGNED FOR YOU

Discharge Planning and Social Services

When patients complete their short-term rehabilitation, our Social workers coordinate the services they will need following discharge. These services may include: visiting nurses, home health aides, meals on wheels, and physical and/or occupational therapy. In addition, they will arrange for any equipment needed by the patient. Our professional Social Services Department plays an important role in helping residents adjust and thrive in our community. In addition, you can count on our staff to serve as advocates for residents and families. You can also turn to us for information on topics such as heart disease, diabetes, cancer, Alzheimer's and other medical educational materials.

West Hartford Health & Rehabilitation Center provides a secure, self-contained 30-bed unit that has been therapeutically designed to meet the needs of residents with Alzheimer’s or other forms of dementia. The special care unit promotes resident independence while providing comfort and safety. This enhances the resident’s awareness and orientation and enables us to accommodate different levels of functionality. Our goal is to maximize the functional potential of each resident by fostering an environment that allows them to maintain their dignity and self-determination.



ALZHEIMER'S

The right environment to reduce resident stress

There is no question that people with dementia need special care. In addition, to help them function better, they also need a specially designed environment. Our dementia unit was created to provide the right amount of sensory stimulation while promoting a feeling of calmness and relaxation in patients. Some of the unit’s special features include:

- Brighter lighting, to eliminate shadows
- Special slip-resistant flooring, which eliminates glare and minimizes the potential for falls
- Handrails, to promote mobility and independence

Medical expertise and support

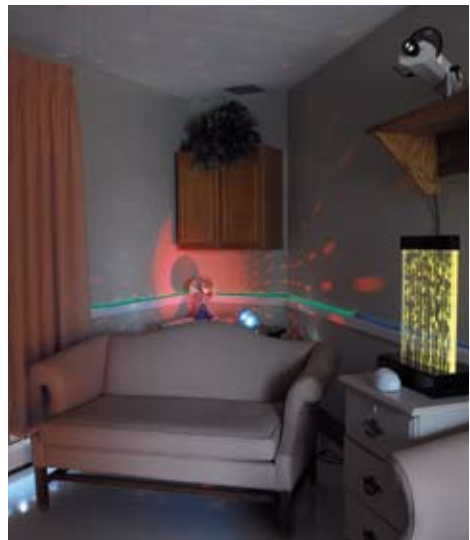
Geriatric specialists, including our associate medical director, psychiatrists, and other geriatric clinicians regularly visit the unit. Because dementia can affect a person's behaviors, activity and behavior therapy are important aspects of the program. Attention is also provided to the resident's loved ones, since dementia can be particularly difficult to deal with emotionally. West Hartford Health & Rehabilitation Center offers support groups, educational seminars and other resources to help families cope.

Care providers are qualified by the Alzheimer's Foundation of America and certified by the Alzheimer's Association

To strengthen their knowledge and skills, all of the staff members who work in our unit complete an extensive training course endorsed by the Dementia Care Professionals of America (DCPA), a branch of the Alzheimer's Foundation of America. This training ensures that each staff member has a proven level of knowledge and skill in the provision of care to patients with dementia. In addition, staff members employ a "Snoezelen Approach" to care. This safe, non-threatening form of dementia therapy gently stimulates the primary senses and does not require an intellectual response from the patient. This ensures freedom from failure, improving the therapeutic relationship since the activities enable caregivers to build patient trust and communication.

S E R V I C E S

- Contrasting colors to help residents distinguish between walls and doors, plates and tablecloths, etc.
- Pictorial signage, combined with large print descriptors to help with way finding and orientation
- Noise reduction measures including acoustical ceiling tiles and sound-absorbing design materials to minimize over-stimulation and distraction
- Appropriate seating, enabling residents to sit down and stand up more easily and avoid falls
- Unit-wide security system, including motion detectors if appropriate, to enhance patient safety and security





Insurance Coverage

West Hartford Health & Rehabilitation Center is Medicare and Medicaid certified, and contracts with many insurance providers. We coordinate direct billing with most major insurance companies. Our Admissions Director will be happy to guide you through the necessary procedures to ensure coverage.
